## **Saudi Trademark Protection**

Saudi Arabia is a member of the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and follows the International Classification of Goods and Services for the Purposes of the Registration of Marks under the Nice Agreement, with revisions and additions adopted as of January 1, 2002. A separate application should be filed with respect to each class of goods or services. Trademarks covering alcoholic goods and related retail or wholesale services are not applicable within the Kingdom.

## What is the process for registering a Mark?

Trademarks registered in Saudi Arabia are protected for a period of 10 Hegira years from the date of application. Registrants can apply for renewals of the Mark within the last year of validity or within a grace period of 6 months after expiration of the Mark.
